Child Protection/CRB Policy

The club must adhere to sound and recommended Child Protection guidelines as laid down by the FA. The club must demonstrate it has one primary Child Protection Officer, i.e. The Club Welfare Officer, to act as the single point of contact with the FA and County FA. That officer must have attended at least one of the designated courses in Child Protection, provided by the FA and run by the County FA which should be updated every three years. In addition, all those running teams must have attended a First Aid course, a Safeguarding Children Course, and be able to provide evidence of this to the FA.

All those associated with the management and coaching of children, all Committee Members and all volunteers who have direct contact with children must go through the latest CRB and Police record checks, and health vetting procedures. Our club upholds these policies to the full, and will continue to do so.
