



CODE OF CONDUCT – FOR MANAGERS & COACHES

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each person, treating each equally in the context of sport
- Place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including performance
- Adhere to the guidelines laid down within the constitution and the rules of the FA
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with each player based on trust and respect
- Do not exert undue influence to obtain personal benefit or reward
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Ensure that the activities they direct are appropriate for the age, ability and experience of the players
- Clarify at the outset with players what is expected of them, and what they should expect from the coach
- Clarify at the outset with parents what is expected of them, and what they should expect from the coach
- Ensure that players and parents of players new to the Club have proper induction into Club policy and code of conduct
- Promote the Code of Conduct to players, parents and spectators alike
- Never condone behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game
- Consistently display high standards of behaviour, and be a role model for players, parents and spectators
